

DAY 1: ARRIVAL BALI

DAY 2: BATIK WORKSHOP - SILVER WORKSHOP - WOOD CARVING WORKSHOP - UBUD PALACE - UBUD ART MARKET - ALAS HARUM - TEGALALNG RICE FIELD - KINTAMANI - DINNER $[B_1L_1D]$

After breakfast, get ready to explore the uplands of Bali, which is Ubud. Ubud is known for its art. Stop at batik, silver, and wood carving workshop. Prepare to be awed by how they make all those beautiful things. Next, visit Ubud Palace, an important and historical place here in Ubud. Make a stop at Ubud Art Market to do some shopping. Before lunch, visit Alas Harum to ride the famous swing and take pictures with Tegalalang Rice Field as its background. Continue your journey to Kintamani and have lunch in Oculus Kintamani with Mount Batur and Batur Lake as its view. Kintamani is famous for its coffee plantation, you can also coffee tasting there. On your way back to the hotel, have dinner in Queen's Tandoor, an Indian Restaurant.

Have some lunch at TT Beach Club and move to Nyang Nyang Beach. Here, optional paragliding activities can be done, the beach is also known as the cleanest of the Uluwatu beaches and is home to awesome graffiti shipwrecks. Continue your journey to Uluwatu Temple to watch the famous Kecak and Fire Dance. On your way back, visit Jimbaran to have dinner by the sea.

DAY 5: HANDARA GATE - ULUN DANU BERTATAN TEMPLE - TANAH LOT [B,L,D]

After breakfast, picked up at the hotel and begin your journey to the Northern part of Bali. Have a short stop at Handara Gate to take some Instagramable pictures. Next, visit Ulun Danu Beratan Temple which sits in the highlands of the mountainous Bedugul Regency. Have a stroll around the temple and have lunch with Baratan Lake as its view. Before sunset, continue your trip to Tanah Lot. It is one of the important directional temples in Bali. The temple is located on a rock. On your way back to the hotel, have an Indian dinner in Spice Mantra.

DAY 6: FREE AND EASY - BALINESE SPA - SUNSET DINNER CRUISE [B,L,D]

LOMBOK & GILI ISLANDS

Lombok has its own unique version of culture and society at a much slower pace. You can easily catch a plane from Bali for 30 minutes or ride a fast boat for 2-3 hours from Sanur.

Lombok's natural beauty offers volcanoes, islands with pristine white sandy beaches, clear warm waters, and jungle terrain. Lombok is also blessed by the culture of traditional Sasak villages. There, you can see its unique architecture and textile vendors.

Trekking up to the top of Mountain Rinjani (3.726 m) with its magnificent volcano peak scenery, especially at sunrise. Mount Rinjani also offers hot springs and a panoramic crater lake that you can enjoy to reward yourself after a tiring trekking trip.

Soft trekking to Senaru Village

Where rainforest and rice terraces meet, where wild nature blend with local Sasak culture... Here the sounds of tropical forest, bird song give way to the thunder of the towering Sindang Gila Waterfalls.

The brave may even venture for an exhilarating bath behind the white water curtain. Alternatively, just relax in the cool shade of a rain forest gain and enjoy scenery around you. Usually the long tailed monkey also show their existence by getting close to the visitor.

From the waterfall, you will guided walk to continue along the slopes of Mount Rinjani to several beautiful viewpoints above the river.





Gili Islands

The sublime Gili Islands are also a worthwhile place to visit. Here, can experience diving or snorkeling, exploring the underwater world of Gili. There are also lots of other diverse marine activities.

Gili islands are blessed with crystal clear water, white sandy beaches and outstanding marine life. Three Gilis located in the North-West corner of Lombok: Gili Trawangan is the largest, most touristic and most developed, Gili Air with its relaxed pace and chilled out vibes and Gili Meno the smallest of the three with its village-like atmosphere. Boating 20 minutes from south west coast of Lombok, you will visit Gili Nanggu, a tiny island with white beaches but note yet untouched by tourism.





Yogyakarta is a city with cultures and customs as rich as they were centuries ago. This town works like a time machine that will transport you into the past. Yogyakarta offers an abundance of Javanese art, painting, silverwork, batik handcraft, traditional Javanese dances, Gamelan, the wayang kulit (leather puppet) theatre, and other expressions of traditional art that will keep the visitor spellbound.

Stroll around the Sultan's palace or Kraton Yogyakarta, learn silversmithing at Kotagede, and do a shopping spree at the traditional market of Malioboro. The surroundings of Yogyakarta are also definitely not to be missed. Wake up early and catch the sunrise at Borobudur in Magelang City. Visit the tourist villages and mingle with the locals. Last but not least, try Gudeg: a traditional dish from Yogyakarta that will leaveyour tongue in awe.



DAY 01: YOGYAKARTA AIRPORT - MERAPI LAVA

Arrive in Yogyakarta at noon then meet and greet with your guide at Airport then next drive to the Kaliadem area located on the slope of Mount Merapi to enjoy the activity of this Volcano from the closest distance, and start for the Lava Tour. With a 4WD Jeep, exploring the real and the most exotic part of the foot of Mount Merapi after the eruption is charming. Late afternoon drive to Yogyakarta and check in at your hotel and stay overnight.

DAY 02: BOROBUDUR TOUR - DIENG PLATEU


In the morning, visit the magical temple of Borobudur, the largest Buddhist temple in Indonesia that was built in the 9th century. This huge Buddhist pyramid is the largest Buddhism shrine in Indonesia. From your guide, you can learn the Buddha philosophy by exploring the relief at Borobudur temple, and back to the hotel. Then you will continue to visit Dieng Plateau, you will explore the Arjuna temple, a complex of Hindu temples built in the early 7th century and well known as the oldest Hindu temple in Indonesia. Then continue to visit Sikidang crater, one of several craters in the Dieng plateau that is most active, and Lake Warna (Color Lake), an exquisitely beautiful lake ranged by highland forest, the water color is turquoise and cobalt hues from the amount of sulfur reflected by the sunlight. On your way to Dieng or on your way back, you will see the beauty

DAY 03: YOGYA CITY TOUR - PRAMBANAN

After breakfast then a full-day tour visits Yogyakarta city tour by visiting Sultan Royal Palace, Water Castle (Taman Sari), Batik Home Industry, and Silverware at Kotagede. Lunch will be provided at a Local Restaurant. Then after lunch, continue to Prambanan Temple, Prambanan is a ten-century-old Hindu temple. This temple is dedicated to the Hindu God Shiva, locally called Candi Loro Jonggrang, which means 'slender virgin'. Late afternoon drive back to your hotel and stay overnight.

DAY 04: YOGYAKARTA - AIRPORT

Breakfast at the hotel, and a free program until the appropriate time transfer to Yogyakarta Airport





Komodo Islands is a must-visit destination for those who love nature, culture, and wildlife. Komodo Islands is the best place to see the last dragon on earth, the Komodo Dragon.

The park includes the three large islands Komodo, Padar, and Rinca. The park's terrain is uniquely diverse, consisting of a mountainous hillside, tropical rain forests, grass-woodland savannah, and pristine white sandy beaches that harbor rich marine biodiversity. The marine environment in the Komodo National Park is one of the world's richest in flora and fauna and is still relatively undiscovered.

Cruise along the sea and visit the beautiful islands of Komodo, and the pink beach, and trek to the top of Padar Island. Get ready to be amazed by thousands of flying foxes flying over you when you pass Kalong Island at sunset. Explore the incredible underwater life of the Komodo Islands, awed by the beautiful coral and fishes.

Normally, there are two ways to enjoy the Komodo Tour.

The first way is by speedboat. This is the best option for those who have a minimum time of traveling, yet you can still explore lots of popular tour highlights in one day:

Komodo island trekking to encounter the dragon; trek up and enjoy the spectacular view of Padar Island; Long Pink Beach where you can chill; Taka Makassar Island, known as the sand island; Snorkeling at Manta Point and Kanawa Island.

Note that joining or private tours by speedboat can be chosen

The second option is by liveaboard/phinisi. You will be staying for a minimum of 3 days and 2 nights in the boat, sailing through the sea of Komodo Island.

DAY 01: LABUAN BAJO AIRPORT - SNORKELING - KALONG ISLAND.

Pick you up from your hotel. We will make a quick stop in a store where you can buy personal things to bring on board such as snacks and soft drinks. Off to Komodo National Park, First, stop at Kelor Island for snorkeling. Those with good physical conditions can hike up the hill to enjoy the breathtaking view from the top of the island. Then we slowly cruise to Kalong Island (Flying Fox Island). In the late afternoon, you enjoy an amazing display of thousands of flying foxes flying out of the island in search of food while the sun is setting down.

DAY 02: PADAR ISLAND - PINK BEACH - TREKKING ON KOMODO ISLAND.

Early in the morning, we cross to Padar Island for a morning hike on Padar Island before it gets too hot. Hike to the top of Padar Island takes around 30 minutes or depending on your fitness level. Reaching the top of the island, you will be rewarded with a stunning panoramic view. Padar Island is the third largest island in Komodo National Park; the island is relatively small at just 16 km2 and stands at 269m above sea level with rugged topography Padar. Return to the boat and sail to Pink Beach which is located around a 30-minute boat ride from Padar's pier. Spend time enjoying the pristine pink sand and crystal clear water. Lunch is served on a boat while the boat is sailing to Komodo Island. Afternoon trekking on Komodo Island. Komodo Island is the largest island within Komodo National Park. Before starting the trekking, you will be given a safety briefing and information about the biodiversity of Komodo Island. Return to the boat for dinner

DAY 03: SNORKELING IN KANAWA ISLAND – LABUAN BAJO

You will enjoy snorkeling or simply relaxing on the beach on Kanawa island. Kanawa island offers incredible underwater life. At the appropriate time, return to Labuan Bajo and then transfer to the airport to catch a flight to the next destination.





DAY 01: ARRIVAL ENDE – MONI

colored lakes of Kelimutu.

Upon arrival in Ende visit the Exile House of Mr. Sukarno - the world-famous Indonesian Founding Father. Lunch in Ende. Afternoon visit Wolotopo, a typical coastal settlement of Lio ethnic with an animistic shrine and Ikat weaving. Drive then towards Nuabosi until you reach the vantage point to enjoy an aerial view of Ende town which is fortified with volcanoes and beautifully located on the south coast of Flores. Arrive at Moni village in the afternoon, check in at your hotel, and overnight.

DAY 02: KELIMUTU -ENDE - BAJAWA

Departure at dawn for Kelimutu volcano and its colorful acidic lakes. After one hour drive, you will hike for 30 min before reaching the viewpoint over the triple crater. From turquoise green to brownish red and deep black, each lake is the repository of the souls of the dead, and it is breathtaking when the sun shines upon the whole crater. Back to your hotel, then departure for Riung, with a stop at Pengganjawa Beach with its blue pebbles shores, where you will be able to swim and meet the pebble pickers and the fishermen and Wologai, a traditional Lionese village situated on a beautiful forested hill set with a splendid panorama of Lepembusu Mountaintop. Arrival at Bajawa and the end of the day. Overnight in Bajawa.

DAY 03: BAJAWA - BENA VILLAGE - RUTENG

Bajawa is located in the heart of the Ngadha ethnic civilization, which is known for its megalithic culture. There are traditional villages furnished with stone monuments, ancestor worship shrines, and Adat Houses. The hamlets are beautifully settled in the volcanic mountainous area. The most beautiful ones are Bena and Gurusina. Visit those villages and in the afternoon drive to Ruteng. It is another beautiful driving day; you will pass the villages and rainforests. stops will be made at Aimere village to see "arak" distillation and fresh palm juice tapping and at "Ranamese" the rainforest lake To stretch your legs stop and trace the trail in the cloud forest. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant and overnight in Ruteng.

DAY 04: RUTENG – LABUAN BAJO

Proceed to Labuan Bajo. En route visit Liang Bua Cave and Cara village in the Cancar area to see the unexposed world wonder - the Lingko - the spider web-shaped rice fields. Visit also the Ruteng traditional market and continue the drive to Labuan Bajo, Lunch will provide on the route, and arrive at the town in the afternoon and transfer to a hotel, take a rest, and stay overnight.

DAY 05: KOMODO DAY TRIP (SHARING TOUR BY SPEEDBOAT)

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Labuanbajo harbor and board your speed boat. First, we will visit Padar Island, one of the big three islands in the komodo national park, arrive at padre island, and start trekking up for 30 minutes to the hill of the famous Padar island viewpoint to see the magnificent view of Padar Island. Next, visit the famous 'Pink Beach' that offers a beautiful marine life of corals and colorful fish. After spending some time here snorkeling, have lunch on the boat. The final visit is to Komodo Island to see the Komodo dragon, where we will do an hour of trekking to Banugulung, the former feeding ground to see Komodo in the wild. On our way to Banugulung, you will see other wildlife such as wild pigs, deer, and various colorful birds. Return to your boat and back to Labuan Bajo harbor. Late afternoon transfer back to your hotel in Labuanbajo and free program at your own leisure.

DAY 06: LABUAN BAJO DEPARTURE

After breakfast at hotel at the appropriate time transfer to airport of Labuan bajo to your next destinations.



Sumba is a small island in the eastern part of Indonesia, part of the lesser Sunda islands. The island is divided into four regencies, each home to the main town. Tambolaka in Southwest Sumba, Waikabubak in West Sumba, Waibakul in Central Sumba, and Waingapu in East Sumba. Sumba is famous for its beautiful landscape, hill, sunset, megalithic grave, and mostly for its hand-woven fabric or known as Ikat.

East Sumba is especially famous for its Ikat. It is internationally renowned for its warp ikat textiles, especially the dramatically decorated man's blanket – known in the Kambera region around Waingapu as a hinggi. Yet its less well-known pahikung textiles, some of which incorporate warp ikat, are far more sophisticated and much more technically demanding to weave.

DAY 01: TAMBULAKA - WAIKABUBAK

Upon arrival at Tambulaka Airport, you will be welcomed by our guide representative and then transfer to Hotel Manandang hotel or similar to check in and have lunch. In the afternoon visit Prai Ijing, Tarong, and Waitabar Village nearby Waikabubak. Continue your trip down to the local market of Waikabubak. In the afternoon, return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 02: WAIKABUBAK-WAINGAPU - RENDE

After breakfast at Hotel, check out and start driving overland to Waingapu (East of Sumba) within a 137 km distance. On the way, a stop can be made to Pasunga village to see the Greatest stone Grave and the traditional houses of Sumba. Arrive in Waingapu, check in at the hotel, and have lunch. An afternoon with a 2-hour drive to Pau Dan Rende Village to see the Kingdom of Greatest stone grave and some of the traditional houses one of them its wall built from the Buffalo skin and as the center of Ikat traditional weaving. We pass through the Melolo, and on the way, enjoy the widest and most beautiful view of the grass field with its cattle. Afternoon drive back to Hotel. Dinner and overnight at Hotel.

DAY 03: WAINGAPU - TRANSFER OUT

After breakfast at the hotel, free until time to transfer to the airport for the flight to the next destination.







Mount Rinjani Trekking Package, explore the active volcano located on Lombok island. It can easily be reached by plane within 25 minutes from Bali and by speed boat for 2-2.5 hours.

Stands at 3726m and making it the second-highest volcano in Indonesia, Mount Rinjani trekking is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Lombok. People usually do 2 days and 1-night trips to reach and enjoy the summit. However, you can choose to get a longer trip to take your time and enjoy more of what's inside Mount Rinjani. The experience of enjoying sunset and sunrise with a beautiful view from Mount Rinjani is one you shouldn't miss out on.

On the summit of Rinjani, you can see beautiful scenery and a volcanic crater called Segara Anak. With a large of 1.100 hectares and a depth of 190m, Segara Anak is also known as a local's popular fishing spot. In 1985, the government started breeding fish in the lake. This lake is approximately 2,000 meters (6,600 ft) above sea level and is estimated to be about 200 meters (660 ft) deep. The other amazing thing you can enjoy here is the hot springs from the caldera. After tiring trekking, soaking your tired body in a natural hot spring will make you feel better and relaxed.

Indonesia is home to 147 volcanoes and around 76 of these volcanoes are active ones. These volcanoes are also spread on the islands of Java, Lesser Sunda, Sulawesi, and Sumatra.

ADVENTURE INDONESIA organizes volcano trekking such as; Semeru, Kerinci, Arjuno Welirang, Bromo, Ijen, Gede Pangrango, Batur, Agung, and Carstensz Pyramid.





Borneo Orangutan Tour Tanjung Puting National Park is one of our best-selling travel destinations. Our tour is more than simply bringing visitors to see the Orangutan. Besides experiencing the lush rainforest of central Kalimantan, visitors can also take part in keeping the home of the Orangutans safe.

DAY 01: PANGKALAN BUN - ORANGUTAN TOUR

Arrive at Pangkalanbun airport and go straight to Kumai to board the boat. The boat is a traditional Klotok wooden river boat size 2,25 m x 15 m for 5 people and the big one size 3,5 x 19 meters for 8-10 people with a roof which forms the upper deck where you can view the rain forest as it glides by. In the afternoon, we'll slowly explore the quiet river with the klotok while observing the monkeys along the riverside. Dinner and overnight onboard with a simple mattress and pillow.

Accommodation: On Boat (klotok boat)

DAY 02: ORANGUTAN TOUR EXPLORATION.

After breakfast, board the klotok and travel up the river for about 2 hours boating to Camp Leakey. The place where the older orangutans used to be reintroduced into the rainforest. En route stop at Pondok Tanguy, the former rehabilitation center for the new ex-captive orangutans. At both places, you will have the opportunity to trek into the rainforest with your expert guide and the forestry rangers to appreciate the flora as well as perhaps encounter the wild orangutans, gibbons, macaques, and birds. Meals are provided on the boat. In the afternoon, visits to the feeding station to see rehabilitated orangutans. Continue the trip, and sail back down the river overnight in a klotok boat. Accommodation: On Boat (klotok boat)

DAY 03: ORANGUTAN TOUR-NEXT DESTINATION

After breakfast, boat down to Kumai before transfer back by car to Pangkalan Bun airport for your flight to the next destination.








Borneo is famous for the Dayak tribe. This indigenous tribe of Borneo has unique culture and customs compared to the Indonesians whom you usually see in cities. It is suggested that you attend the Dayak festival that is held annually.

Dayak Tribe Borneo at Kubung Village is located more or less 300 km away from Pangkalan Bun or more or less about 4-5 hours drive by car. This village has a "sister village" called Sekombulan Village and is about 5 km away from the border of West Kalimantan and Central Kalimantan Province. This village belongs to Dayak Tumon and they believe in Hindu Kaharingan while some already being Christian, Catholic, as well as Muslim.

Dayak Village

In Miau Baru Dayak village you will see a beautiful rice barn, gates, a traditional long house, a dance, and much exotic wood carvings. We will stay overnight at the local simple homestay. Traditional dances can be arranged upon request.





Sumatra is an ideal destination for adventurers looking for something beyond the ordinary. Starting from the Orangutan sanctuary in Bukit Lawang, North Sumatra, visit the spectacular volcano at Lake Toba, coffee plantations, and the Batak tribe village life. You can continue to the land of the Minangkabau people or Way Kambas National Park in the West. Experience climbing Mount Kerinci, the highest volcano in Inndonesia.

DAY 01: MEDAN - BERASTAGI

Pick up from the airport and drive directly to Berastagi, a mountain resort with its refreshing weather and magnificent mountain scenery which has an abundance of flowers, vegetables, and fruits (most famous of which is the "Marquise" passion fruit). Here you can visit the famous fruit market and continue to Gundaling hill to view two active volcanoes, Sinabung and Sibayak. Overnight stay in Berastagi.

DAY 02: SIBAYAK SUNRISE TREKKING - LAU DEBUK-DEBUK HOT SPRING

Early morning drive to the slope of Sibayak volcano and then start climbing to catch the sunrise after taking a rest and enjoy it the view, start trekking back down and continue to Lau debuk-debuk natural hot spring to enjoy and relax soaking at the hot water pool then back to the hotel.

DAY 3: BERASTAGI - SAMOSIR ISLAND


After breakfast, you proceed on the journey to Samosir Island. A stop will be made at Dokan village, a traditional Karo Bataks village, Sipiso-piso waterfall you will walk down to the waterfall, Long house of Simalungun Bataks. During the trip (approximately. 4,5 hours drive) you will also pass the local spices garden: coffee, cinnamon, clove, etc. In the afternoon you arrive in Parapat from where you cross the lake by ferry to Samosir island. Samosir Island is situated in the huge crater of Lake Toba. It is the heart of Batak culture which has a unique and interesting culture. The friendly and welcoming Batak people love music and singing. Many traditional villages are located along the Samosir Island shoreline. On the east side of the island, the land rises steeply from a narrow strip of flat land along the lake's water edge climbing to a central plateau that towers some 780 meters above the waters. From this height, one can have a wonderful panoramic view of this magnificent blue lake.

DAY 04: LAKE TOBA EXCURSION

Today you will make an excursion to explore the beauty and cultural aspects of Batak visiting Ambarita village to see the stone chairs, tables, and courtyard of Siallagan's clan. Simanindo to enjoy the Batak's traditional ritual dances. Continue to Tomok village to see the old tomb of King Sidabutar. The rest is your own program, you can take a beautiful walk or ride a bicycle (optional) or take a rest in a hotel.

DAY 05: SAMOSIR - MEDAN AIRPORT

Early in the morning, you cross the lake by ferry to Parapat from where you drive to Medan through the plantation route and Pematang Siantar city. Arrive in Medan we will transfer you to the airport to catch your flight to next destination.



JAKARTA

As the capital city of Indonesia, Jakarta is a huge, metropolitan city. It is a hive of activity, a buzzing city and it's full of people! This will be the first thing you notice in the city, especially with all the traffic in Jakarta. Though, regardless of traffic, there's a heap of the best things to do in Jakarta that are well worth a gander if you're visiting for a few days. This sprawling exciting city is the hyper-center of Indonesia and absolutely worth taking time to explore when in the area. There is a wide range of attractions to enjoy from quirky museums to a variety of national monuments, government areas, and business districts.

Jakarta is also a great place to learn more about Indonesia's complicated history, and you can visit a variety of culturally and historically significant locations such as the old town and the port which will give you a glimpse of how the city would have looked in past times.

Have a visit to Fatahillah Jakarta History Museum, Wayang Museum, Museum Gajah, Museum of Fine Arts & Ceramics, Sunda Kelapa Sea Port, Planetarium, Bank Indonesia Museum, Textile Museum, Jakarta Cathedral, Isitqlal Mosque, National Monument, and many others. As well as harking back to the days of old, Jakarta is one of the most modern cities in Indonesia, and you can spend time embracing this cutting-edge side of the city at its famous malls, bars, and restaurants. Jakarta is also known as one of the cities that own big shopping malls, for those who want to go shopping it is a good place to visit.



Have a serene time, ride a speedboat from Jakarta and you can visit the Thousand Islands. It is known for great beaches, snorkeling, diving, and a short nature getaway for those who get no time to visit Bali.





With a few hour drive from Jakarta, there are lots of destinations and activities that can be done. Drive around 6 hours from Jakarta and you can visit Ujung Kulon National Park. Here, in the western part of the island of Java, you can meet the endangered species, the Javanese Rhino. Cross the island of Java and you can visit Krakatoa. A caldera in the Sunda Strait between the islands of Java and Sumatra. Krakatoa is known as the most famous volcanic eruption in history. Drive for 4-5 hours, you can meet the people of Baduy. An indigenous Sundanese ethnic group native to the southeastern part of Banten.

For those who love to have another thrilling adventure, hiking Mount Gede can be one of the options. Located in West Java, around 2 hours drive from Jakarta, you will reach the starting point of the Mount Gede hiking trip. As it is one of the most famous mountains in the area, we suggest you do trekking on weekdays instead of weekends.

On the foot of Mount Gede, you can visit Bodogol Nature Reserve. Walk deep into the jungle of Bodogol, walk on the canopy bridge, and observe the rich diversity of flora and fauna life of the park. The park is home to the Javan eagle, Javan gibbon, Lutung, etc.

There is also a big waterfall that offers a nice wash-up after the tiring walk on this day. Have about 2 hour trip under the thickness of the jungle in the afternoon today. A good place to camp.

From Jakarta, you can combine your tour with visiting Bogor Botanical Garden, Tea Plantation, and Taman Safari in Puncak, or continue your trip to Bandung.





Ride a car for 3-4 hours to Bandung, A lovely place to escape from the hot weather of Jakarta. When in Bandung, don't forget to visit the Tangkuban Perahu crater, an active 2000 m wide, surrealistic volcano at 1800 meters above sea level. Here, you can have a light trekking around the crater. Continue your trip to Ciater Hot Spring by passing through the huge wonderful tea plantation. You can take a bath in the hot natural water pool. A perfect activity to do as Bandung is known to have cool weather.

Bandung is known as the City of Angklung. Angklung is a traditional instrument made from bamboo. Have a visit to Saung Angklung Udjo to see the performance of angklung and learn how to play it.

For those who love history, Museum Asia Africa is the perfect place to visit. Another famous museum in Bandung is the Geology Museum. The collections of this museum include fossils, rocks, and minerals. In this historic museum, you can also learn about natural disasters, use resources, process energy, and study the earth.

Drive south to visit Kawah Putih (White Crater), a breathtaking crater lake and tourist spot in a volcanic crater. The crater was discovered in 1837 by Dr. Franz Wilhelm Junghuhn, a German-Dutch botanist.

As Bandung have cool weather, they are famous for their strawberry. Visit a Strawberry Farm where you can directly pick your own strawberries at the farm that has been provided. While picking straw berries you will be treated to a beautiful view of the surrounding South Bandung, such as landscape tea gardens, paddy fields, and mountains. Besides strawberries, Bandung is also famous as the biggest tea producer in Indonesia. Visit Situ Patenggang Lake and Tea Factory to observe the process of tea from its root to the end.





Located near the island of Bali, East Java has lots of beautiful places to visit. Two of them are Mount Bromo and Mount Ijen. People frequently have their Bromo Ijen tour from Bali. It is more convenient as you can cross by ferry from Gilimanuk Port of West Bali to Ketapang Port in East Java for an hour. Even though both volcanoes are famous in East Java, Mount Bromo, and Mount Ijen have different points of uniqueness.

DAY 01: BALI - BANYUWANGI (IJEN)

Pick up from the airport or your hotel in Bali and meet your guide and directly drive to Bali harbor for around 4 hours and cross to Java island by ferry. Arrive in Ketapang harbor in the afternoon and check in at your Banyuwangi area.

DAY 02: IJEN TREKKING - CEMARA LAWANG (BROMO)

At midnight at around 01.00 am, you will wake up and then departs for the whole day excursion to Mt. Ijen. Ijen Crater shows a special type of volcanic feature common to Indonesia, about 1 km in diameter and 175 meters deep. The floor is covered completely by a warm lake, milky blue-green in color, held back by a dam built many years ago by the Dutch, in order to keep the hot mineral, laden water from raining on the crop lands below. In certain parts, of the crater, you will see the blue fire. After sometimes you will climb up to the rim of the crater and enjoy the sunrise light warming you up. Trekking down the mountain and rejoin the coach and back to the hotel for breakfast and clean up then afterward continue to drive to Bromo for around 6 hours driving to the Cemoro Lawang area for overnight. You will enjoy the different views along the road, from the toll road to the hilly terrain with the vegetable and fruit farm along the road. Lunch on route at a local restaurant. Arrive at Cemoro Lawang and directly check in to your hotel and take a rest and prepare for the next early morning program. Dinner will be on your personal account.

DAY 03: BROMO SUNRISE TOUR - SURABAYA AIRPORT OR TO THE NEXT DESTINATION

At 4 am the 4WD will bring us to the world's most famous viewpoint at Mt. Pananjakan (2,750 m) on the rim of the Tengger caldera to enjoy the sunrise breaking over the volcano cones including Mt. Bromo and an active Mt. Semeru in the background. The views are breathtaking. We continue across the sand sea to the active Mt. Bromo volcano and climb the 2245 steps to visit the crater (2,500 m). Horseback ride included, then the 4WD jeep will bring you back to the hotel for breakfast. After having breakfast and cleaning up and checking out the hotel then proceed to Surabaya. Lunch at a local restaurant on route when leaving back to Surabaya. Arrive at Surabaya airport or train station in the late afternoon then continue your trip to the next destinations.





Even though there are flights available every day from Jakarta to Bali, Java Overland Tours is one of the things you can do while visiting Indonesia. Through this tour, you can explore the island of Java by crossing from Jakarta to Bali, or vice versa. On your journey, you can see lots of historical places, a diversity of cultures, beautiful landscapes, and many other things. If you have more time, we suggest you stay a little bit more in cities that we visit along the journey. As every place holds its own charm.

DAY 01: JAKARTA - BANDUNG TOUR

Early in the morning, drive to Bandung for approximately 3 hours and visit Tangkuban Perahu crater, an active 2000 m wide, surrealistic volcano at 1800 meters above sea level. Have light trekking around the crater Continue to Ciater Hot Spring by passing through the huge wonderful tea plantation. Here, you will have lunch and take a bath in the hot natural water pool. In the Afternoon back to Bandung, have a stop at Padasuka village and enjoy the Angklung (traditional bamboo instrument) performance at Saung Angklung Ujo.

DAY 02: BANDUNG - YOGYAKARTA

Early breakfast at your hotel, then transfers to Bandung train station. You will take Indonesia's most popular public transportation, the train, to travel to Yogyakarta. Upon your arrival in Yogyakarta, your guide will pick you up and then directly transfer you to your hotel in Yogyakarta.

DAY 03: BOROBUDUR - CANDIREJO

In the morning you will visit the magical temple of Borobudur, the largest Buddhist temple in Indonesia that was built in the 9th century. This huge Buddhist pyramid is the largest Buddhism shrine in Indonesia. From your guide, you can learn the Buddha philosophy by exploring the relief at Borobudur temple. Continue exploring Candirejo village, a traditional Javanese village that is rich in its natural surrounding and being promoted for village tourism, portraying traditional Javanese culture and day life through traditional houses, plantation resources, art performances, farming, and local food. You will participate in daily social activities to feel their real traditional village atmosphere, their culture, and lifestyle. Finally, transfer to your hotel in Yogyakarta.

DAY 04: YOGYAKARTA CULTURAL TOUR - PRAMBANAN - RATU BOKO

After breakfast, you will start your cultural Yogyakarta tour by visiting Sultan Royal Palace, and Water Castle (Taman Sari)Then the journey continue to visit Prambanan temple, the most important Hindu temple built on compound IX century by the three temples dedicated to Brahma, Shiva, and Vishnu. Then visit Ratu Boko, Ratu Boko is an archaeological site known to modern Javanese as Kraton Ratu Boko or Ratu Boko's Palace, Ratu Boko displays attributes of an occupation or settlement site, although its precise function is unknown. Probably the site was a palace complex before back to your hotel and you can enjoy the time on your own personal leisure.

DAY 05: YOGYAKARTA – BROMO VIA TOLL ROAD

At the appropriate time, we drive to East Java, and to Bromo Highland. We will need some 6.5 hrs to drive today. Mount Bromo is an active volcano that stands at 2,329 meters. Bromo is located in the Bromo Tengger Semeru National Park. The slope of the mountain is cultivated by the local Tenggerese farmers with market of vegetables. The Tenggerese history can be traced back to the peoples of the Majapahit Kingdom who fled their land following an eruption from Mount Merapi. They are the only group of Hindus left in Java today. We have an early night in preparation for the sunrise climb tomorrow.

DAY 06: BROMO - MADAKARIPURA - SURABAYA DEPARTURE

On this day we will get up very early we get up at 03.00 in the morning for a cup of coffee or tea before heading out for a short drive of approximately 3 kilometers to Pananjakan. For the last 1.5 kilometers, we walk up to the highest viewpoint in the area to watch the sunrise. But of course, you can watch the sunrise depending on weather conditions. Then we descend to the sea of sand to see the crater of Mount Bromo. After this activity back to the hotel for breakfast in Madakaripura. After arriving in Madakaripura you will be greeted by the fresh air is still beautiful, about 30 minutes walk to reach the waterfall you will see a very beautifu! waterfall and a compliment to your holiday after a stopover in Bromo. After enjoying the Madakaripura waterfall you will be taken to the airport of Surabaya, and fly to your next destination.



Tana Toraja is thought to be one of the most breathtaking terrains in Sulawesi as well as Indonesia. While it stands out as one of the beautiful regions in South Sulawesi, Toraja is one of the ethnic groups in Sulawesi, known to have a unique culture based on animistic beliefs.

Tana Toraja is surrounded by mountains, tombs, lush greenery, and rice paddies. The village has its distinctive Tongkonans which is a traditional ancestral house shaped like a boat where the deceased are often kept and cared for. It's one of the only locations where you can visit a traditional village and be witness to their ancient burial rituals which are known to be some of the most complex in the world. Tana Toraja is a land with spectacular nature and unique culture.

DAY 01: MAKASSAR - PALOPO - TORAJA

Enjoy your breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Palopo. After arrival in Palopo, we will drive for 2 hours to Toraja on a very scenic Road. Arrive at Toraja land and start to visit the fascinating villages of Toraja with the unique Tongkonan Houses which shape like a ship's bow and stern. LEMO, the graveyard on the cliff. Afternoon visit LONDA, an ancient natural grave, and puppets on the balcony representing the dead. KETEKESU, traditional Toraja village.

DAY 02: TORAJA TOUR

This morning after breakfast, if the schedule permits, you will have the chance to immerse yourself in the bustling life of the Torajans with a visit to their, once-a-week traditional Buffalo market in Bolu. This market is important to the local society as buffalos and pigs are an essential part of the intricate funeral ceremony. N In case there is the market is closed on the day you visit, we will replace it with a visit to a local market in Rantepao or on the next day. After visiting the market, visit BATUTUMONGA, a mountainous area with fantastic scenery passing through the green paddy field. On the way visit the ROCK graves. Soft trekking passes the village to see the way of life of the Toraja people. Palawa, the oldest village of Toraja with old Tongkonan houses and rice barns surrounded. Then visit BORI, the stone showing the existence of the funeral site of the clan. Afternoon visit NANGGALA, a traditional village with Fantastic Tongkonan houses surrounded. MARANTE, the hanging graves. If you want to see the local Market, please ask your guide to have a stop before back to your hotel.

DAY 03: TORAIA - PALOPO - MAKASSAR - DEPARTURE

Enjoy your breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to Palopo for a flight to Makassar. Arrival in Makassar take another flight to next destination.





Located in North Sulawesi, Manado is the second largest city in Sulawesi. Famously known for its culinary, nature reserve, and underwater world. Bunaken National Park is a popular spot for scuba diving and snorkeling, especially for those who love macro diving. The other interesting place is Lake Tondano, the largest lake in North Sulawesi. You can spend time here chilling and eating the local food by the lake. Visiting the Tangkoko Nature Reserve can also be a good idea. There, you will see Macaca Nigra (black crested monkey), Tarsier Spectrum (the tiniest monkey), Phyton, Horn Bills, Sulawesi Bear Cuscus, Vipers, and many other birds. If time permits, in the afternoon trekking, we will reach the Tarsiers' nest by the time they leave their nest for their nocturnal activities

DAY 01: MANADO - TANGKOKO NATURE RESERVE

Upon arrival at Sam Ratulangi International Airport, you will be picked up and meeting service by our guides. Drive for two hours to reach Tangkoko Nature Reserve. After check-in, if time allows we can have afternoon trekking (latest at 17:00) to reach the Tarsiers' nest by the time they leave their nest for their nocturnal activities. Dinner in Home Stay with grilled fish and delicious dishes.

DAY 02: TANGKOKO - MINAHASA HIGHLAND - TOMOHON

Wake up very early, we have hot tea and coffee. Begin trekking before sunrise, early in the morning to the jungle to see the Tarsier Spectrum set back home after their nocturnal activities. As well as some groups of Macaca Nigra move around the forest for their morning activities. Return to Homestay for breakfast and shower. After breakfast, we will leave Tangkoko. We then proceed to the highland of Minahasa with some stops at the ancient Tomb of Minahasa People (Giant Stone Ages), and the historical World War II Japanese Tunnel System. Lunch will be in a restaurant by Tondano Lake. After lunch, we will enjoy the wonderful lake scenery from the Urongo On Hill Tree House. The journey continue to visit the hot spring and pine forest of Lampasan before chilling down at the beautiful multi color of Linaw Lake to enjoy the afternoon in a cozy restaurant by the lake sipping coffee with the traditional famous snack of Pisang Goreng (fried banana) and other traditional snacks and cookies. Tonight we spend the night in a nice hotel in this cool town of Tomohon and dinner in a local restaurant with traditional Minahasa cuisine with a view of Manado city.

DAY 03: TOMOHON - MAHAWU - TRADITIONAL MARKET - MANADO

After breakfast, start our tour by visiting the traditional market of Tomohon where there is a section of the market called Extreme Market where we can see many kinds of mammals and reptiles sold as Minahasan delicacies. We then proceed to Mt. Mahawu crater. After 10 minutes of trekking to the top of the crater, we will enjoy the magnificent view of the cities of Tomohon and Manado and the islands beyond. We then visit the center of the knock-down Traditional house industry with some stops at the Pagoda Buddhist Temple with the flowers plantation surrounding. After lunch in Tomohon, we move down to the coastal town of Manado with some stops at the iconic Jesus Blessing Statue, Ban hin Kiong Temple in China town and Second World War Monument. Tonight we spend the night in a nice hotel in Manado. Dinner in a restaurant with a beach view.

DAY 04: MANADO - BUNAKEN

Breakfast and get ready for your adventure to Bunaken National Park. Proceed to the harbor in Manado and get on board Bunaken island using a chartered wooden boat to enjoy the beauty of underwater marine life with colorful healthy corals and various kinds of fishes in the area of the National Park of Bunaken. Arriving on the island we will change the boat to a catamaran/glass bottom boat where we can enjoy the underwater beauty from the boat. With some stops at some point, we can change to swimsuits and do snorkeling to get even closer to the fish and coral. Lunch will be served in a restaurant on the beach. Overnight at Bunaken Island

DAY 05: BUNAKEN - MANADO

After breakfast, get ready and prepare your next trip to other parts of Indonesia or hop on your flight back home.





DAY 01: SORONG - WAISAI - MANSUAR ISLAND

Upon arrival at Domine Eduard Osok Airport in Sorong, you will be met and transferred to the ferry port to board the public ferry. We recommend you arrive in Sorong by morning flight around 6:30 AM. The ferry will depart from Sorong at 09:00 am and arrive at Raja Ampat's capital Waisai at 11:00 am. Arrived in Waisai and transfer by another 40-minute speedboat ride to your resort/hotel/lodge, where you will stay for 3 nights. Arrived and explore the hotel.

DAY 02: KABUI BAY

After breakfast, start the full-day tour to Kabui Bay to see beautiful karst islands and the famous rock of Batu Pensil. If it is during low tide, we can also visit the exotic sand done by Pasir Timbul either before or after Kabui. Packed lunch will be provided during the trip. Return to hotel for dinner and rest.

DAY 03: PIAYNEMO

Breakfast and start your trip to visit Piaynemo Geo-Site. Get ready for a walk-up through 325 wooden steps to reach the top of the hill from where you will be fed by a mind-blowing view over the turquoise lagoon and all the surrounding karst islands. As we descend the hill, we will do a little hike through the rocky hill to see the famous Telaga Bintang, the starshaped lagoon located closely adjacent to the Piaynemo viewpoint hill. Wearing comfortable trekking shoes is well recommended. On the way back, we will stop over at the island village of Arborek, a great place to interact with local villagers and see some local handicraft-making. Packed lunch will be provided during the trip. Get back to the hotel for dinner and rest.

DAY 04: MANSUAR ISLAND - WAISAI - SORONG

After breakfast, we will leave Raja Ampat Dive Lodge by speedboat to Waisai to catch the 09:00 am ferry and bring you back to Sorong. Upon arrival in Sorong, our staff will meet and transfer you back to the airport/hotel.





We will take you to experience an exciting adventure by exploring the Baliem Valley and the unique, primitive traditions and way of life of the tribes who live in the valley.

Baliem Valley Trekking is one of the highlight activities while visiting Papua. Get a chance to trek down the beautiful countryside of Papua. Drive 40 minutes from Wamena and you will arrive at Sogokmo Village, the Baliem Valley trekking starting point. Baliem Valley trekking scenery is incredibly beautiful. Explore the traditional Papuan tribe. small villages and local people working in the field while trekking down the valley.

Dani is one of the largest tribal groups living both in the southern and northern Baliem Valley. They are scattered all the way from the hilly terrain and the flat land in the valley. Theyi still live traditionally. One of their uniqueness is their round shape house, built from wood and grass. Their main source of livelihood is sweet potato planting and pig raising. They also still practice their old traditional way of living. The wooden spear, wooden ax, bone knife, and bamboo arrow are still used daily. It shows by their clothes too. The man of Dani wears only a penis gourd, while the woman wears a grass skirt. However, with the modern influence, some young people living near Wamena have worn T-shirts.

There is a big festival every August, in the Baliem Valley. By attending the massive Baliem Valley Festival, visitors will have a rare chance to learn and experience first-hand the different traditions of each tribe participating in the festival without having to make the difficult trek to their compounds deep in the hinterland of West Papua. All you need to do during the festival is just observe and enjoy the mock war. It's a lifetime experience not to be missed.
